

Our solution will improve the way we dispose of stormwater because problems can be reported quickly and addressed immediately before they become too unmanageable. *Stormwater Community Watch* allows you to report a problem to wastewater management facilities as soon as you see it just by scanning the QR code which will be installed near each storm drain. GPS will be attached to the photo file so the problem can be located by water management facilities.



The main goal of the program:

Make reporting problems EASIER

# Program Benefits

- Creation of a database/photo log of each issue reported
- Track number of site visits & illicit discharge reports received annually
- Track the number of corrective actions initiated in response to reports received annually
- Track the estimated volume of stormwater pollution removed in response to reports received

# Implementation

- We have been awarded a \$5,000 grant from Indiana American Water to be put toward purchasing supplies.
- We will begin developing Public Service Announcements, newspaper articles and similar forms of public proclamations to announce the rollout of the *Stormwater Community Watch* program in the near future.
- We are currently seeking additional funding or the donation of in-kind services to further develop and expand on the website.
