

MARKLAND LOCKS & DAM TOURS!!

As an attendee of the conference you can join our U.S. Army Corps of Engineers guided tours of the Markland Locks and Dam located just 2.5 miles from Belterra.



The Markland Locks & Dam is located on the Ohio River. It is 26.5 miles upstream from Madison, IN and 3.5 miles downstream from Warsaw, KY. The navigation locks are located on the Kentucky side of the river. The upper pool above the dam extends upstream for a distance of 95.3 miles to the Meldahl Locks and Dam.

Friday, September 9th from 1:30 to 2:30p.m.**

- **Each tour is limited to only 30 attendees per tour!**
- Limited parking is available at the Markland Locks & Dam visitor center so attendees are encouraged to carpool from Belterra.
- If families would like to bring their children they can, but would have to stay in the visitor area and not be allowed on the lock walls.
- Anyone coming on the portion of the tour where we will walk over to the chamber and look at equipment on the lock wall will need to be 18 years of age.
- Also anyone going on that portion of the tour will need to have on full length pants, closed toe shoes, and show a valid form of identification.
